

## **2010 FLU IMMUNIZATION CLINICS**

The [Fresno County Department of Public Health](#) recommends that all people in high risk groups should get vaccinated. These groups include children 6 months to 18 years old, people 50 years old and older, pregnant women, anyone with certain chronic medical conditions, and health care workers. Parent or legal guardian must be present for children under 18 years of age. Be sure to bring along all immunization records and your child's Medi-Cal card. H1N1 flu shots are free.
