## FRESNO COUNTY LIBRARY COMMUNITY BRANCHES

Within the 5,000 plus square miles of the Fresno County Library System lie 22 branches referred to as the Community Libraries. These libraries service the county's outlying communities and pocket communities near the metro area. They range in size from the 375 sq ft Big Creek Library at the northern border to the 7,510 sq ft Bear Mt Library and Community Center toward the east. There is the historical Laton branch to the south built in 1904, and the Mendota library to the west scheduled to open in early fall of this year.

These libraries offer standard library services such as public computer access, reference materials and media items such as DVDs and CDs. There are newspapers, magazines and of course books. Some of them contain special collections. The Kerman Library is home to the largest collection of Punjabi materials in the state. It contains more than 3,000 titles of books, movies and music in the Punjabi language. Auberry library is home to a special collection of Native American items including manuscripts, photos, historical audio tapes, and of course books and videos. You will find a collection of Large Print materials at the Senior Resource Center as well as information of particular interest to the senior community. All of the community branches differ, reflecting the

specific needs of their local community in the materials and programming provided at each location. There is nothing cookie cutter about these libraries. There is a strong commitment at each of these locations to serve the needs of their own special community recognizing the unique quality each of them possess.

While many of these libraries are housed in store fronts, community centers and other buildings, Fresno County has committed itself to improving the facilities of these locations. Auberry, Kingsburg and Parlier have all recently undergone improvements to their branches and there are new buildings on the horizon. Mendota, Tranquility and Orange Cove are all scheduled for new buildings with funding for each provided in a variety of ways, including state grants, measure B funds and local funding. The new Fowler Branch is scheduled for ground breaking in July and was funded in part by measure B but with large local donations as the community recognized the need in this small town for an improved library facility.

The staff in these libraries are responsible for everything from shelving the books to answering reference questions and providing programming. They are an active part of their communities and that reflects their dedication. These branches may not have the large collections of bigger locations, but their commitment to providing service to their public truly makes them the heart of their communities.
